Free Domestic Tourism Certification for Thompson Okanagan Region

The Tourism Skills Training (TST) Program will prepare participants to work in various tourism and hospitality positions in the Thompson Okanagan region with a focus on serving domestic markets through traditional and/or self-employment positions. In this fully funded, full-time online program, participants will receive instruction, mentorship, employment coaching, and job placement support over 13 weeks.

Applicant Eligibility Requirements:

- Living in Thompson Okanagan region of British Columbia (including Shuswap, Boundary Country, Similkameen, and Gold Country/Nicola Valley)
- Legally able to work in Canada
- Currently unemployed or precariously employed (casual, seasonal, or part-time)
- Over 15 years of age
